

**CITY OF MANCHESTER
STREET COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

The Street Committee of the City of Manchester met in session on Monday, March 14, 2022 at 5:30 PM.

Present for the meeting were: Director Gannon, Office Manager Moore, Alderman Messick, Alderman Nickels, Alderman French, Adam Carter with St John Engineering, Animal Control Officer Brandon, Donald Parker, Rick Clouse, and Angie (Rep. Hollinsworth Family)

First Item discussed was to approve the minutes from January and February. Motion made by Alderman Nickels to approve the minutes, Second by Alderman French Passed 3-0

Second item discussed were comments from the citizens. None

Third item discussed was abandoning right of way at Living Water Church. Mr. Clouse stated he would like to build a couple of houses on this land. There was some further discussion on this. Motion made by Alderman French to approve the abandonment of this right of way, Second by Alderman Nickels Passed 3-0

Fourth item discussed was abandoning the right of way of Haley Dr. update on sidewalks. Mr. Adam Carter with St John Engineering updated the committee on the sidewalks. There was further discussion on this.

Fifth item discussed were the dumpsters behind City Hall. It was brought up that these need to be moved from behind City Hall to the Street Dept. Director Gannon stated that he would like to check with Director Fox about putting the dumpsters at either the Fred Deadman ark or the Dave King Park. There was some further discussion on this. Motion made by Alderman French to move the dumpsters, Second by Alderman Messick. Passed 2-0 Alderman Nickels voted no due to useless voting on this.

Sixth item discussed was an update on the sidewalks. The Stret Dept is laying tile on phase 1 for Hillschapel Rd sidewalk. Once finished on Hillschapel will move to Coffee St. There was some further discussion on this.

Seventh item discussed was a street light on Brookhollow. The pole is already there just needs a light added. Motion made by Alderman Nickels to send to the board, Second by Alderman French Passed 3-0

Other items of interest: Exit 111 power should be turned on in the next couple of days

Exit 110- wires are old and shortening out, ballast are bad. Director Gannon to get a price for new interstate lights at this wxit
