First item discussed was to approve the minutes from May meeting. Motion made by Alderman Swan to approve minutes from May, Second by Alderman Elam. Passed 2-0


Second Item discussed was Comments from citizens. None

Third item discussed was the Proposed Commercial Waste Recycle Fee. The list needs to be review and will be discussed at the next Street Committee Meeting. This was tabled. Motion made by Alderman Swan to bring this back at the next meeting, Second by Alderman Elam. Passed 2-0

Fourth item discussed was the Final Approval of the Paving and Stripping List. Director Carter stated that the paving would not go over the \$ 200,000 allotted in the budget. Some further discussion on this. Motion made by Alder Elam to approve the paving list, Second by Alderman Swan. Passed 2-0

Fifth item discussed was the converting of traffic signals to LED and Pedestrian accessibility. Director Carter had a quote from S&W for the lights at Jackson St and Spring St. The state had contacted Director Carter and stated that they were going to pave Hwy 41. Director Carter is to get with S&W to get a new quote for this without the ADA ramp and present it to the committee at the next meeting. There was some further discussion on this. Motion made by Alderman Swan to move forward with Jackson St lights, Second by Alderman Elam. Passed 2-0
