Ordinance:

- a. 2nd reading of an ordinance of the City of Manchester, Tennessee, adopting a budget for the fiscal year July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023; sponsored by Alderman Bellamy. Alderman Nickels made a motion to approve and seconded by Alderman French. Mayor Howard opened the floor to discussion and after none called for the roll. The ordinance passed 2nd and final reading 5-0.

Police Chief Yother stated the applicant has met all requirements and is favorable for the Special Event Beer Permit. Alderman Nickels made a motion to approve and seconded by Alderman Patton.
