

ORDINANCE NO. 1446

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE TO ENTER INTO A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WITH THE SECRETARY OF THE AIR FORCE FOR FIRE PROTECTION AND HAZARDOUS MATERIALS INCIDENT RESPONSE

WHEREAS the City of Manchester, Tennessee customarily enters into Mutual Aid Agreements to benefit its citizens arranging for additional resources to be deployed in the event of an emergency or disaster; and

WHEREAS the Secretary of the Air Force, by letter dated December 8, 2014, has offered to enter into a revised Mutual Aid Agreement with the City to make available resources located at Arnold Air Force Base, TN, in the form attached as Exhibit "A;" and

WHEREAS Federal law permits these Agreements provided the City reimburse the United States at the rates set forth in 44 CFR Part 151 and, depending upon the emergency, these costs could exceed Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000); and

WHEREAS, Code Section 5-703 (4) of the City of Manchester requires any obligation of the City on any contract in excess of \$25,000 be approved by ordinance; and

WHEREAS the City of Manchester, Tennessee desires to enter into the Mutual Aid Agreement, as submitted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that the City of Manchester, Tennessee enter into the Mutual Aid Agreement with the Secretary of the Air Force attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Mayor and Finance Director are authorized to execute the contract documents on behalf of the City of Manchester.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Manchester, Tennessee that this Ordinance shall take effect on and after its publication and passage, the public welfare of the City of Manchester, Tennessee requiring it.
