

ORDINANCE NO. 1473

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE PURCHASE OF TWO POLICE VEHICLES FROM AL WHITE MOTORS, INC. AT A COST OF FIFTY-FIVE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$55,672)

WHEREAS the City of Manchester advertised for bids for police cars specifying several alternates; and

WHEREAS two bidders submitted bids in response to the advertisement; and

WHEREAS, after consideration of the advantages and disadvantages of the vehicles bid, the City has determined that the option with the factory “Ready for the Road” package is the most advantageous to the City; and

WHEREAS the City believes it in the City’s best interest to purchased two marked police cars; and

WHEREAS the lowest responding bid for two marked “Ready for the Road” equipped police cars was submitted by Al White Motors, Inc. in the total amount of \$55,672; and

WHEREAS funds sequestered pursuant to T.C.A. 39-17-420 (Drug Fines and Forfeitures) are sufficient to fund this purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that the City of Manchester purchase two marked police vehicles with the “Ready for the Road” package from Al White Motors, Inc., pursuant to its bid, at a total cost of Fifty-Five Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Two Dollars (\$55,672) with payment to be made from those funds sequestered pursuant to T.C.A. 39-17-420.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that this Ordinance shall take effect on and after its publication and passage, the public welfare of the City of Manchester, Tennessee requiring it.
