

ORDINANCE NO. 1492

AN ORDINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH TYLER TECHNOLOGIES FOR CITY COURT SOFTWARE AND RELATED SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF FORTY-ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED NINETY-THREE DOLLARS (\$41,893) PLUS ANNUAL MANAGEMENT, MAINTENANCE AND UPGRADE FEES OF APPROXIMATELY FIVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED NINE DOLLARS (\$5,409) FOR EACH YEAR AFTER THE FIRST

WHEREAS the City of Manchester, Tennessee solicited proposals for City Court computer software and related services; and

WHEREAS the most advantageous proposal was submitted by Tyler Technologies in the amount of Thirty-Five Thousand Five Hundred Five Dollars (\$35,505) for license fees, hosting applications, implementation services, professional services, data and conversion assistance fees and cash-collection hardware; Six Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-Eight Dollars (\$6,388) in estimated travel expenses and Five Thousand Four Hundred Nine Dollars (\$5,409) for annual license fees and hosting fees after the first year, a summary of which is attached as Exhibit "A; and

WHEREAS the City of Manchester, Tennessee believes it to be in its best interest to enter into said contract; and

WHEREAS, Code Section 5-703 (4) of the City of Manchester requires any obligation of the City on any contract in excess of \$25,000 be approved by ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that it enter into a contract with Tyler Technologies in the amount of Thirty-Five Thousand Five Hundred Five Dollars (\$35,505) for license fees, hosting applications, implementation services, professional services, data and conversion assistance fees and cash-collection hardware; Six Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-Eight Dollars (\$6,388) in estimated travel expenses and Five Thousand Four Hundred Nine Dollars (\$5,409) for annual license fees and hosting fees after the first year, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that this Ordinance shall take effect on and after its publication and passage, the public welfare of the City of Manchester, Tennessee requiring it.
